Items not listed in these standards are not permitted. Please check with CVCA's Main Office if you have questions.

Students are required to be in code during school hours Monday through Friday 7:50 a.m. to 2:50 p.m. Remember that beyond school hours, the PRINCIPLE of MODESTY is always in effect for all CVCA events on and off campus. Anything which draws attention to oneself serves more to distract from this principle rather than to promote it.

<p><b>TOPS</b> <i>Monday through Friday</i> Tops may be purchased through Kids Kloset, Young's, Ritchies, Squad-locker, or BSN. <b>Some items offered at these locations may not be approved for everyday uniform wear.</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>CVCA Polos (long or short-sleeved)</li> <li>CVCA Quarter-zips</li> <li>CVCA Hoodies</li> <li>CVCA Sweatshirts</li> <li>CVCA Letterman Jackets</li> </ul>	<p><b>All tops must be solid colors in black, royal blue, and gray, with the exception of hoodies/ sweat-shirts. See below.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Polos (black, royal blue, gray) and quarter-zips monogrammed with CVCA-approved logos only</li> <li>May wear a solid color (white, royal blue, black, or gray) crew neck shirt (short/long-sleeved) under polo or quarter-zip</li> <li>May wear solid-color (royal blue, black, or gray) polo under quarter-zip or hoodie/sweatshirt – <b>Undershirt must be visible if wearing quarter-zip or-full zip.</b></li> <li>Hoodies/sweatshirts (including full-zip) from CVCA-sanctioned activities may be worn (sports, clubs, classes, Houses) – <b>Must have in-code tops underneath if outer layer is removed.</b></li> <li>Must wear in-code top under letterman jacket</li> <li>No other outerwear may be worn during the school day</li> <li>Polos may be tucked in with a belt or cover the belt loops when untucked</li> </ul>
<p><b>HOUSE SPIRIT WEAR and CVCA SPIRIT WEAR</b> <i>Thursdays &amp; Fridays ONLY</i></p>	<p>House/Middle School Grade-level T-shirts (long or short-sleeved) CVCA Spirit Wear T-shirts (long or short-sleeved)</p>	<p><b>House shirts (long or short-sleeve) may be worn on Thursdays and Fridays ONLY</b> <b>CVCA Spirit Wear T-Shirts permitted Thursdays and Fridays ONLY</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>May wear solid long-sleeved shirt underneath a CVCA Spirit Wear or House T-Shirt (NO patterns, letters, words, stripes, or thermal underwear)</li> </ul>
<p><b>PANTS</b></p>	<p>Chino/Khaki Style</p>	<p><b>Pants full-length, straight leg, boot-cut, jogger*, cargo</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Solid color tan khaki or black ONLY</li> <li>Jogger* style is permitted in tan khaki ONLY</li> <li>No leggings, yoga pants, tights, or sweat pants</li> <li>Shorts are not permitted</li> <li>Modest and appropriate fit for school culture</li> </ul>
<p><b>SHOES</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Athletic tennis shoes only</li> <li>Boots November through March only</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Shoes must be clean and in good repair</li> <li>Socks must be worn</li> <li>Closed toe and fully covered heel</li> <li>No sandals/slides, Crocs, Birkenstocks, Hey Dudes, slippers, mules, clogs, rain boots, five-fingers, or vented water shoes</li> </ul>
<p><b>SOCKS</b></p>	<p>Required</p>	<p>Any style/color that maintains a respectful design is appropriate (i.e., footie, crew, knee-length)</p>
<p><b>BELTS</b></p>	<p>Encouraged but not required</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Business attire</li> <li>Solid color: black, brown, gray or white</li> </ul>
<p><b>HAIR</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Neat and well-groomed</li> <li>Natural color</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Please contact the Main Office BEFORE getting a questionable hairstyle or change in color</li> <li>Hair should be styled so that one or both eyes are NOT covered (Students may be asked to pull their hair back)</li> <li>No extreme hair styles (i.e., shaved portions, spikes, etc.)</li> <li>No unnatural colors (i.e., blue, pink, green, etc.)</li> <li>Facial hair is permitted as long as it is neatly trimmed and well-groomed</li> </ul>
<p><b>MEN ADDITIONAL GUIDELINES</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>May wear a reasonable amount of business-attire jewelry (No earrings; Jewelry should not be excessive)</li> <li>Tattoos should not be visible at any time</li> <li>May NOT wear make-up, including nail polish</li> <li>Hats and hoods are NOT to be worn in the building at any time</li> <li>Bandannas and scarves are NOT to be worn during school hours</li> <li>Pant and shirt chains are not permitted</li> <li>No Blankets</li> <li>Clothing should not be ripped, cut, or modified in any way. (example: removing the neckline of a sweatshirt)</li> </ul>	
<p><b>LADIES ADDITIONAL GUIDELINES</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>May wear a reasonable amount of business-attire jewelry (should not be excessive)</li> <li>Pierced body parts, other than ears, are NOT in code</li> <li>Tattoos should not be visible at any time</li> <li>Make-up should be modest and not draw unnecessary attention</li> <li>Hair accessories must be school appropriate-no Tinsel</li> <li>Hats and hoods are NOT to be worn in the building at any time</li> <li>Bandannas and scarves are NOT to be worn during school hours</li> <li>Pant and shirt chains are not permitted</li> <li>No Blankets</li> <li>Clothing should not be ripped, cut, or modified in any way. (example: removing the neckline of a sweatshirt)</li> </ul>	

## Enforcement of Student Appearance Standards

### First Office Referral: Warning

1. An email is sent to parents informing them of the nature of the SAS infraction and that a second infraction will result in two lunch detentions.
2. Documentation of the violation is recorded in Facts SIS (formerly RenWeb).

NOTE: If a student is unable to correct the violation, they may be asked to remain in the Office until it can be corrected.

### Second Office Referral:

1. An email is sent to parents informing them of the nature of the SAS infraction and that a third infraction will result in an extended office detention.
2. The student receives two lunch detentions.
3. Documentation of the violation is recorded in Facts SIS (formerly RenWeb).

NOTE: If a student is unable to correct the violation, they may be asked to remain in the Office until it can be corrected.

### Third Office Referral and Beyond:

1. An email is sent to parents informing them of the nature of the SAS infraction and that any subsequent infraction will result in an extended office detention.
2. The student receives an extended office detention, with potential loss of PRT.
3. Documentation of the violation is recorded in Facts SIS (formerly RenWeb).

NOTE: If a student is unable to correct the violation, they may be asked to remain in the Office until it can be corrected.
