WHEN/WHERE:

- January 10 8th graders and trip staff do not have school!

Prepare to Believe is a life-impacting experience where students experience the <u>Ark Encounter</u>, <u>Creation</u> <u>Museum</u>, <u>Newport Aquarium</u>, <u>National Museum of the US Air Force</u>, and so much more together! Teachers and mentors guide students through the museums, where they explore, ask questions (big and small), dig deeper, and gain answers from the Bible for some of life's toughest questions. Creation, the Fall, the Flood, Tower of Babel, Adam, Eve, Cain, Abel, Noah, and his family...were these real events and real people? And if so, what does this mean for our lives and God's plan for our salvation?
