

School Day ACT – All CVCA Juniors

March 11, 7:50-11:45 a.m.

All CVCA juniors have been registered for the ACT on March 11. No registration by students/parents is required.

However, two Action Steps are needed before the School Day ACT:

1. Link MyACT account with your Student Code
2. Review and Prepare

Link MyACT account with your Student Code

Before March 11, log into myact.org for one of two situations:

1. You **already have** a MyACT account
 - a. Log in to myact.org
 - b. Enter your email and the password you used to set up your MyACT account
 - c. On the right side of the home page, find the Enter Student Code button. Carefully enter your Student Code, shown at the top of the ACT handout you received in Bible class
 - d. Your last name and date of birth on your account must match what is listed at the top of the same handout. To update your name or DOB, contact Mrs. Fridline.
2. You **do not have** a MyACT account
 - a. Log in to myact.org
 - b. Select Create MyACT account, then “I’m new! Let’s get started.”
 - c. Create an account with your name and email address
 - Name and DOB – Your last name and date of birth must match what is listed on the ACT handout you received in Bible class.
 - Email Address – It is recommended that you use a personal email, not your CVCA email. If you do not have a personal email, it is time to create one. To create a Gmail account, first create a Google account. Start the habit of checking your personal email account often, using it in your college search process
 - d. Enter Student Code – Once you have created your MyACT account, you will be sent a Verification Code by text or email. You have 24 hours to use it. There will be a few more questions to answer before moving to the home page, where you will find the “Enter Student Code” button. Carefully enter your Student Code, which is found at the top of the ACT handout you received in Bible class.
3. Additional Details:
 - a. Use this MyACT account to access scores, prepare for tests, and register for future tests.
 - b. Use your MyACT account to list four colleges of interest so that your scores will be sent directly to the schools. You may send scores later for an additional fee. This must be completed before the test or up to two days after the test. Colleges will not look at your scores unless they are instructed to do so through your application. Updated scores can be sent if you take the ACT more than once.

Review and Prepare for the ACT on March 11

1. Naviance Test Prep – ACT prep is available on all juniors’ Chromebooks by logging into their Naviance account. Free full practice tests and many practice problems are available.

Register to take the ACT again, and bundle and save! Students who register for the April, June, or July ACT will have the opportunity to select a bundle for \$99 and receive a voucher for a second test anytime through Summer 2026.
